Limits: must be 18 to test drive, 1 donation of 20\$ per household, survey must be completed in order to count towards donation, 8 new model ford cars and trucks will be available. Softball tournament at LHS could draw people in. 300 people needed to make the potential limit of 6,000 given to LHS football. No hassle sales drive. Boosters asked to staff the event. 4 per shift - 5 shifts = 20 volunteers needed. Would need to get info out to area businesses. Billie will have flyers printed and LaShonda has volunteered to pass them around the area on Wednesday.

Billie Peavler:

Average volunteer participation is between 15% 18%. Have to increase that number to at least 50% in order to streamline events.
- Fundraising needs to start now so that we don't have to work so hard during the season. All ideas are welcome! Send an email to any of our booster representatives or class reps.
- TREASURER: This position has to be filled. Needs to be a shared position. A background in accounting is extremely helpful. Please let Billie Peavler know ASAP if you are interested or would like more information. We can

hire a bookkeeper for the necessary paperwork but money needs to be counted onsite and deposited with records kept of collections.

• Advertising person needed to make sure all fundraising events get posted to public avenues such as FCPS channel 13, possibly Lee Cruse if time/event permits, etc. If this sounds right up your alley, please let us know!
